# THE LORD'S TEMPTATION

### **Luke 4.1-13, p.859**

The subtheme for our 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter focus on holiness is called The Imitation of Christ. Holiness is basically about living like Him. In our first lesson of this series, we want to consider how he dealt with temptation.

### Doctrine

Luke is teaching us more in this passage than merely the way to defeat sin is to proof-text passages at Satan. He wants you to see that your power for defeating sin is found by trusting in the New Adam, Jesus Christ. When you're united to Jesus by faith, his power for conquering sin becomes yours.

*What is Luke's point in comparing the three "sons" of God: Adam, Israel, and Jesus?*

### Application

What does it take to begin to fight sin like Jesus?
