## How we can make sense of invective psalms:

- Deep down, we all share the human struggle of inner conflict.
- Historically, their expressions make sense.
- Calls of judgment occur only after love has been extended.
- Sometimes holiness calls for hating the sin that enslaves people.
- Sometimes the absence of anger can be its own alarming sign.
- We should be careful when handling these psalms.
- Psalm 3 itself provides the clue to understanding.
